- Note 1 Rates shown below are annual premium rates per cent for fire and lightning perils and are applicable to Building, Contents and Rent unless stated otherwise.
- Note 2 Attention is drawn to all the Rules given in Section 1 which govern these rates.
- Note 3 Class of Construction is described in Section 2.
- Note 4i) Attention is drawn to the Restriction of Spray Painting/Powder Spraying Warranty 4B in Section 7 which is obligatory to be included in all policies covering manufacturing risks and workshops, except motor repair workshops garages and service stations (with spray painting) under risk code 2806.
 - ii) In respect of the Plastics Risks Category (risks codes 2501-2512), where the trade/occupation process involves Spray Painting, Warranty 4B need not be applied when an additional rate of 0.100% is charged. However, Warranty 24A (in place of Warranty 4B) is to be applied on the policy as spray painting process is being carried out.
 - In the event the insured is unable to comply with Warranty 24A, a loading of 35% (i.e. on base rate plus 0.100%) is to be imposed accordingly.
